## SMALL GROUPS MINISTRY UPDATE

The elders are continuing to pray, discuss, and plan regarding the small groups ministry. Below are some bullet points that we hope will clarify the purpose of this ministry and what has been decided to this point all in the will of the Lord.

1. The dual goals of the small group ministry are:
  - a) to encourage and facilitate the personal study and application of the Word of God through discussion and a forum for asking questions.
  - b) to encourage and facilitate a closer connection between the lives of fellow believers as we provide opportunity to share our needs, what we learn, and how God's Word is impacting our daily lives.
2. The small groups will meet on Sunday evenings.
3. The planned launch date is September 17, 2017.
4. We will begin with 3 or 4 small groups. Two will meet in homes, one will meet at the chapel house, and a possible fourth may meet at the chapel.
5. For those who do not wish to participate in a small group, we will also provide a meeting at the chapel with a brother preaching a message.
6. We want to clarify that the Sunday evening preaching meeting will not be considered "the meeting of the church" with the small groups being options. ALL of the Sunday evening group meetings will be legitimate options. Our Sunday morning meetings along with our Wednesday evening prayer meeting fulfill the pattern of Acts 2:42.
7. The small groups will meet from 6:30-8:00pm. The preaching meeting will be scheduled for 7:00-8:00pm.
8. The small groups will begin by studying the book of James.
9. Each small group will be led by a leader and an assistant leader, all under the oversight of the elders. The leaders will go through training sessions to assist in preparing to properly lead the small groups.
10. The Sunday evening preaching meeting will also be under the oversight of the elders.
11. Participation in a small group does not require one to answer questions or share publicly. Involvement in the discussion is encouraged but not expected.
12. We are planning a Q&A session at which the elders will answer questions about the small group ministry. You are also encouraged to ask an elder any questions you may have at any time. Please understand that all of the questions have not yet been answered as we are continuing to work on additional logistical details.

We see great potential for growth and the meeting of personal and corporate needs through this new ministry. Please be in prayer for the leading of the Lord in all aspects of the planning.
