2018 LIFE CHAIN

On Sunday, October 7, 2:30-3:30 p.m. the 2018 Life Chain will form along Battleground Ave. The National Life Chain is the largest peaceful, prayerful, pro-life, public witness in the world. More than 1,500 cities across the U.S. and Canada are expected to participate this year. SHBC will participate again this year and we hope that you will plan to join us in standing and praying for unborn babies and their mothers.

LIFE GROUPS

Life Groups will restart tonight, September 9th, and will meet on Sunday evenings from 6:30-8:00 pm. We will be studying the book of 1 Corinthians this year. The Life Groups ministry is intended to provide opportunities for fellowship, Bible study discussion, and prayer in the context of a smaller group. Our goal is for each person to grow closer in their connection to God and in their connection to other believers.
